- **Personal Interview**: A personal interview will be conducted during selection.
- **Visitor Policy**: The applicants' Parents, guardians, and personal coaches will not be permitted on the venue (SJU Ground) during the skill and fitness tests.
- **Integrity**: Applicants are advised not to contact the Department of Physical Education or the University to seek influence or recommendations through their academy or any other individual or organization.
- **Equipment**: Applicants are responsible for providing the necessary equipment for their respective games. The University will not supply equipment (refer to the schedule for more details).
