Notification: Readmission to the odd semester UG and PG courses of the academic year 2024-25 regarding

Readmission for the odd semester or for one subject starts on **10th June, 2024**. The last date to apply without late fee is **24th June, 2024** and with late fee is **2nd July, 2024**.

Applicants can be readmitted only for the Ist, IIIrd and Vth Semester for Undergraduate Course and Ist and IIIrd Semester for Post-Graduation Course.

Candidates are expected to print the relevant readmission form (for the entire semester or one subject) that is available on the university website. The duly completed form has to be scanned and sent in PDF format by email to registraroffice@sju.edu.in. The candidates will be called for an offline interview within two-three working days after the form is received. Incomplete forms will be rejected.

Candidates readmitted to the semester will have to pay the fees online by logging into the student portal using the credentials given earlier at the time of admission. It is mandatory to send the transaction details of the fee paid to the university office by email to accountant@sju.edu.in. All candidates seeking readmission should read the guidelines and eligibility criteria given on the university website.

Note:

1. At the end of the semester the attendance of all readmitted candidates will be calculated from the reopening day of the semester i.e., 8th July, 2024.
2. As per the Government Order No. ED 166 UNE 2023, Bangalore dated 08.05.2024, all Universities under the Karnataka State Higher Education department are required to implement the State Education Policy from the academic year 2024-25. Therefore, all students (except B.Voc. B.A. Visual Communication, B. Com, BBA, BCA) seeking readmission to the I semester of the academic year 2024-25 will be required to select an additional optional subject from the three major programmes offered by the University, in accordance with the State Education Policy.

ELIGIBILITY FOR READMISSION FOR THOSE WHO HAD ATTENDANCE SHORTAGE IN EARLIER SEMESTERS

FOR UNDERGRADUATE (UG) COURSES OF THE ODD SEMESTER 2024-2025 (For theory and practical courses):

2019 and earlier batch UG students are not eligible to rejoin in any semester, even if they have one subject attendance shortage.

2020 and earlier batch UG students except students of B.Voc program who had attendance shortage in one course or the entire semester, in theory, need not rejoin the course(s). They can directly apply for the next available regular supplementary examination. They cannot apply for the special supplementary examination. However, 2020 batch B.Voc students are eligible to join Vth semester.

2020 and earlier batch students who had attendance shortage in one course or the entire semester in practical, are eligible to rejoin the course(s) in the Ist, IIIrd, and Vth semesters provided they have got hall tickets to write the theory semester examinations in the respective semesters. They will be allowed to write the practical semester examination only after attending at least 75% of the practical classes.

The 2021 batch students are eligible to rejoin IIIrd and Vth semester.

The 2022 batch students are eligible to rejoin Ist, and IIIrd semester.

The 2023 batch students are eligible to rejoin Ist semester.

Note: As per the Government Order No. ED 166 UNE 2023, Bangalore dated 08.05.2024, all Universities under the Karnataka State Higher Education department are required to implement the State Education Policy from the academic year 2024-25. Therefore all students (except B.Voc. B.A. Visual Communication, B.Com, BBA, BCA) seeking readmission to the I semester of the academic year 2024-25 will be required to select an additional optional subject from the three major programmes offered by the University, in accordance with the State Education Policy.

FOR POSTGRADUATE COURSES OF THE ODD SEMESTER 2024-2025 (For theory and practical courses):

2020 and earlier batch PG students are not eligible to rejoin in any semester, even if they have one subject attendance shortage.

2021 batch PG students are eligible to rejoin for IIIrd semester either for the entire semester or for a course in that semester. 2021 batch PG students are eligible to rejoin for a course in the Ist semester but not for the semester.

2022 batch PG students are eligible to rejoin Ist and IIIrd semesters either for the entire semester or for a course in that semester.

2023 batch students are eligible to rejoin Ist semester.

Please note: As per the resolution passed in the Academic Council 4.8 dated 2nd April 2024, it is resolved to allow students with attendance shortages in one subject to be readmitted only after the VIth semester of their Bachelors programme or IVth semester of their Masters programme. However, if a student is free from the regular semester schedule, they may be readmitted in that semester to fulfill the requirement for the subject with an attendance shortage.

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
