ABOUT THE SPEAKER



Dr.Rathin Barman is an alumnus of Gauhati University. He did post-graduation in zoology with specialization in animal ecology and wildlife biology. In 1998, he was awarded a doctorate for his research on "An ecological analysis of the wetlands in relation to waterbird diversity of Brahmaputra Valley, Assam". A wildlife biologist by training, Dr Rathin Barman has been associated with the Wildlife Trust of India since 2001 and currently is a Joint Director of WTI and Head – Centre for Wildlife Rehabilitation and Conservation(CWRC) near Kaziranga National Park– India's first wildlife rehabilitation centre near a protected area. Dr.Barman is also a member of the IUCN SSC Asian rhino specialist group and threatened waterfowl specialist group.
