He shared that he himself was a product of Jesuit education and considered himself a Jesuit. He recollected his own journey in various Jesuit institutions in India and around the world. He also thanked St Joseph's for the service rendered to the Church. The concelebrants were all the Jesuit priests of Arrupe Nivas. The festal mass on the occasion of the feast of St Ignatius of Loyola brought together the staff and students.

The Eucharistic celebration was the conclusion for the Ignatian week events hosted for all the students on campus. Campus Ministry coordinated the conduct of the Eucharistic celebration. This was followed by fellowship lunch for all the staff of the University. All the students who attended the Eucharistic celebration were provided refreshments. The members of Jesus Youth of SJU distributed prayer cards to all the attendees.
