The Association of Art and Animation (A3) brings creative vision to life with a captivating art exhibition.

St Joseph's University hosted a captivating art exhibition that showcased the exceptional talents of its budding artists on 27 February 2023. The exhibition offered an exceptional display of colourful paintings and innovative installations, highlighting the remarkable talent of the university's artists and their unique approaches to the craft.

Art and Animation (A3) association students of the Institute of Communication and Media Studies hosted an exhibition featuring a range of artworks from abstract pieces to delicate sketches. The exhibition was split into two themes: "Nostu Nostu" (Childhood Nostalgia) containing 30 artworks and "3's a Crowd of Ideas" featuring around 66 pieces.

"It was a very chill and intimate exhibition," said student coordinator Benjamin, adding that the team pulled off a different style of event this year, instead of the monotonous art festival that they hold every year. "Typically, when you do a big event, people are so tired and don't want to do any other event for a whole year because of all the work. But we were so well rested and it felt very peaceful," he added.

The event was conducted as a series of small art exhibitions and included an open mic session with live music and poetry. The audience was entertained by live art demonstrations, gaming, and other activities. Amal Roshan, assistant professor and the coordinator of the BVoc Digital Media and Animation worked closely with the students to ensure a successful program.
