MediaCon 2024, the two-day International Conference conducted by the School Of Communication and Media Studies at St Joseph's University on 23 and 24 January 2024 was a grand success. The theme of the conference Media, Politics, and Governance. The inauguration was a grand affair and included Mr. Pawan Khera, Chairman of Media and Publicity, Indian National Congress (INC), and Prof. Rajeev Gowda, Former MP, and national spokesperson of the INC as the keynote speakers.
