Key points addressed:

Management Analysis: Mr Roongta delved into the significance of management analysis in evaluating financial instruments.

Net Fixed Asset Turnover (Crucial Ratio Yet Mostly Ignored): The guest speaker emphasised the importance of the net fixed asset turnover ratio in financial assessment, highlighting its often-overlooked role.

Behavioral Biases: Mr Roongta discussed common behavioural biases that impact investment decisions, shedding light on the psychological aspects of finance.

'Higher the risk, higher the return' is a myth: He challenged the conventional belief that higher risk necessarily leads to higher returns, providing insights into risk management strategies.

Warren Buffett on Investing: The session included insights from Warren Buffett's investment philosophy, offering students valuable perspectives on successful investment approaches.

After the informative session, students had the opportunity to engage in a Q&A session with Mr Roongta. This interactive segment allowed them to seek clarifications, ask questions, and gain a deeper understanding of the topics discussed.

At the conclusion of the programme at 12:30 pm, Mr Vishal Choudhary delivered a vote of thanks, expressing gratitude to the guest speaker and all participants for their valuable contributions.
