Ref: Request for Additional Academic year to complete the programme. (UG 2018 & PG 2019 batches)

(Registration for the Odd semester examination of 2023-24)

As per the UGC guidelines, all UG students must complete the programme within 5 years and PG students within 4 years. The duration is calculated from the date of the first entry to the respective programme in the college. However, for deserving students, the academic council of the college may extend one additional year for completing the programme.

<u>Eligibility:</u> UG Students whose Registration number starts with 18 and PG students whose registration number starts with 19 only are eligible for this request.

This registration is only for the odd semester examinations of the academic year 2023-24. Students seeking an additional year must write the examinations in the new syllabus and the mode of examination and the pattern of question paper will be the same as that for the regular candidates. Kindly write to the HODs regarding the course code number, title and the syllabus of the paper(s) to be written.

Students who were ineligible to write the examination due to various reasons and status remain the same are not allowed to write the one-time chance examination.

Those candidates who want to apply for the additional academic year must

(i)Fill out the application form & self declaration form and send it to <u>coeoffice@sjc.ac.in</u> along with the scanned copy of the marks statement for the semester(s) in which there is back paper. (ii)Apply for the supplementary examination, October 2023 (to be conducted in November 2023) after the notification.
